If a student is getting help in a certain class, that is fine. You need to check that your child is staying for the extra help and not just staying to hang around with friends. This is not an issue of us not wanting the students here after school; it is a supervisory and safety issue.

After school we have a great maintenance staff that gets our school ready for the next day. They need to do their job and not have to supervise/manage students who are wandering the halls.

Regarding sports practices, if your son or daughter has practice immediately after school, they can stay and get ready for that sport. If practice is later in the afternoon or evening, students must go home or to a friend's house and then return for practice.

Students may not stay at school until a practice if it is later than the end of the school day. We are requiring this with the students' safety in mind. In the past, we have had parents stay and supervise the team until their practice time.
